# Tournament Rules

- RULE 1. ELIGIBILITY** - All bowlers must be currently sanctioned as an **Adult Member** of USBC BA. **(IF NOT SANCTIONED BY BERGEN COUNTY BA, YOU MUST PURCHASE A \$10.00 OUT OF COUNTY CARD.)** Unmarried Grade or High School students under the age of 18 must have written parental consent in order to participate in any sanctioned tournament (USBC Rule 13)
- RULE 2.** USBC RULE 319 A-2 **TEN PIN RULE NOT IN EFFECT**
- RULE 3.** The handicap will be 100 percent of the difference between the scratch figure and the total of the average for each event.
- SCRATCH FIGURE FOR SINGLES.....230**  
**SCRATCH FIGURES FOR DOUBLES.....460**  
**SCRATCH FIGURES FOR TEAM .....920**
- RULE 4.** Bowlers are responsible for verifying his/her own average, whether submitted by the bowler, team captain, or others, (USBC Rule 319a-3). Bowlers must use their **HIGHEST BOOK** sanctioned **WINTER LEAGUE AVERAGE** based on 21 games or more. Each bowler must use an entering average in the following manner. **(NO SUMMER LEAGUE AVERAGES)**
- a 2007– 2008 **HIGHEST BERGEN COUNTY BOOK AVERAGE**, based on a minimum of 21 games.
  - b 2007– 2008 **HIGHEST BOOK AVERAGE**, based on a minimum of 21 games.
  - c If the bowler has no 2007 – 2008 **BOOK AVERAGE**, the bowler’s **HIGHEST 21-game** average, as of **THE DAY OF BOWLING**, will be used. **(MUST BRING LEAGUE SHEET FOR THAT WEEK)**
  - d Bowlers with none of the above-required averages will use an average of **230**.
- RULE 5.** Team event you can enter as many times as you like but must change two bowlers to cash more than once in the prize list. Bowlers may re-enter a maximum of 7 times for Doubles/Singles. The following provisions apply in order to place more than once in the prize list for position standings. Doubles may re-enter as many times as they want but may only place in the prize list once with the same partners. Singles may only cash once. Prize fees in the singles & doubles events will be apportioned 60 percent for gross and 40 percent for net. Winners may collect cash prizes in either the gross or net divisions, but not both
- a *Team event* – At least two players in the lineup must be different to be eligible for multiple cash prizes in team event.
  - b *Doubles event* – At least one player in the lineup must be different to be eligible for multiple cash prizes in doubles.  
B bowlers must compete in both doubles and singles events
  - c *Singles event* – The same individual may not place more than once. Multiple entrants in the singles events may cash only once
- RULE 6.** Bowlers must report 30 minutes prior to their scheduled squad time to have their credentials verified and receive lane assignments.
- RULE 7.** In the team / doubles / singles events, the bowler(s) with the highest net total shall be the Scratch Champion(s) of the event; the bowler(s) with the highest gross total shall be the Handicap Champion(s) of that event.
- RULE 8.** Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Secretary within 24 hours.
- RULE 9.** **It is the bowler's responsibility to comply with USBC Rule 319d and USBC Rule 319a-3. Failure to use proper average or make correction before the completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify the bowler, if the submitted average is lower than the correct average. If a submitted average is higher than recorded and is not corrected up to the completion of the first game of the series, prizes or winnings or both, shall be based on the submitted average. Also failure to provide all registration information will result in a delay of payment.**
- RULE 10.** USBC Rule 319e (Average Adjustment) applies to all entrants. Also any bowler, who has qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more in ANY event in a tournament in the last 12-month period, must report tournament, score, position, and amount won. This information must be attached to the entry form. (USBC Rule 319d)  
*THIS INFORMATION IS REQUIRED FOR SANCTIONED AND NON-SANCTIONED TOURNAMENTS.*
- RULE 11.** When registering for the team event, all current USBC cards must be presented at the same time.  
When registering for the doubles / singles events, each bowler must present a current USBC card.
- RULE 12.** **LANE ASSIGNMENTS WILL BE IN ORDER OF RECEIPT OF ENTRY FORM**
- RULE 13.** Proper bowling attire must be worn during the tournament. **Bowlers must be dressed in a neat and presentable manner. (i.e., no torn shorts, pants or shirts, etc)**
- RULE 14.** USBC Tournament Rules apply.
- RULE 15.** **The Tournament Committee reserves all rights.**

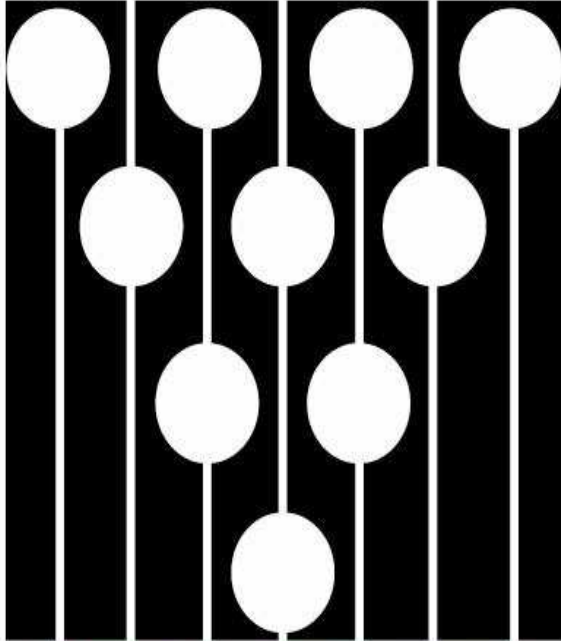
